


*Parts D1 and D2 are identical. *Parts E1 and E2 are identical.

You may also want to consider purchasing RA-LEG-LEVELER-1 which is not included.




ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


1. Install T-Molding in all of the slotted parts and trim to fit.




When making tight bends, it helps to cut a notch in the underside of the T-Molding as illustrated here. This will prevent the T-Molding from pulling out and creating gaps.




2. Install cam lock studs into parts A, B, E1 and E2. Apply light downward pressure while turning. Avoid over tightening, they should be tightened until just seated, no more.




3. Install cam locks in parts C, D1 and D2. Orient the flat face parallel with the edge where it is being installed. Push the cam lock into position and then use a rubber mallet to drive it in until it sits flush.




4. Assemble Parts E1 to D1 and E2 to D2 to make two sub-assemblies. You will notice that the distance from the edge to the cam lock studs is different comparing the top and bottom of the panel. The D Panels connect to the E panels using the studs closest to the edge. Use the #2 Phillips screwdriver to tighten the cam locks by hand, turning just enough to secure them. Do not over tighten, this can damage the cam locks and weaken them.



5. Add the A and B panels to the E-D subassemblies and secure the cam locks. The subassemblies will want to pivot on the A and B Panels, be careful to not allow excessive movement to avoid damaging the T-Molding or the panels.



6. Install the C Panel, use the #2 Philips stubby screwdriver to secure the cam locks. This is best done by turning the assembly on its side and then inserting the C Panel from the opposite side. Tighten the cam locks to the A and B Panels first. When tightening the E Panels to A and B panels, be sure to apply a little pressure to make sure the panels are together before turning the cam locks.
